WE ARE NOW FACING ANOTHER INDOOR DINING SHUTDOWN.

WE COULD LOSE **1/4** OF COLORADO RESTAURANTS WITHIN 1 MONTH.

REVENUE IS DOWN
AN AVERAGE OF **40%**

STAFFING IS DOWN **27%** THAT'S ABOUT **63,450**
LOST JOBS

3/4 OF COLORADO RESTAURANTS SAY THEY'LL CONSIDER CLOSING WITHIN 6 MONTHS IF INDOOR CAPACITY IS RESTRICTED TO **25%**
